The Organizational Committee provides the participants an opportunity to send **an application first** (for drawing up a preliminary program), and **then** to submit the **materials** (but **not later** than September 5, 2017).

The submitted file name must consist of the author's surname and the document title, e.g. *Ivanov\_LWV2017\_materials.doc*.

We will send the invitations to the authors included into the program **before September 17, 2017** by email.

The organizational committee reserves the right to select speeches to be included in the conference program.

*Materials unconfordable to the scientific level and the conference topic, designed with violation of requirements or submitted after the deadline are not considered and not sent back.*

Requirements to the submitted materials: volume – not more than 3 pages. Requirements to the text design: text editor – MS Word, font – Times New Roman, size – 14 pt, margins: 2 cm from each side, line spacing – single.

We plan to publish the conference materials as a result of the conference.

Travel, accommodation and catering expenses are borne by the conference participants or sending organizations.
